DISCUSSION:


On May 9, 2023, the Board appointed a Fiscal Ad Hoc Committee for the new Administration and Operations Facility. Additionally, the Board directed staff to prepare four funding options for consideration. The goal was to update the District's financial model to estimate the impacts to the reserve accounts for the construction of the new Administration and Operations Facility. The lowest responsible bid price for construction of the new facility is \$3,222,327. The four options were presented to the Ad Hoc Committee on May 30th for discussion. The options discussed are as follows:


- All cash
- Finance \$1M 10-year term, 5% interest
- Finance \$1.5M 15-year term, 5% interest
- Finance \$2M 15-year term, 5% interest

Prior to performing the financial modeling, the Capital Budget was updated to accurately reflect actual project costs and the estimated future CIP costs through Fiscal Year Ending (FYE) 2026 (ending of 5-year rate structure).

The impacts to water and sewer reserve balances for each option are displayed below.


Cash Option






Estimated interest paid \$0


Finance \$1M - 10-year term






Estimated interest paid \$272,303.


Finance \$1.5M






Estimated interest paid \$630,702.

This ensures the District can maintain its commitment to improving infrastructure, enhancing services, and meeting the needs of its ratepayers.
