Utilities

Before
□ Locate main utilities shutoffs such as: □ Gas: usually connected to the pipe that runs from the ground to your gas meter □ Electric: main panel usually located on the side of the building □ Water: usually located near the front of the building facing the street □ Label valves, as appropriate, for easy identification □ Take photos of utility shut offs & place in this plan □ Become familiar with the proper ways to shut off each utility □ Gather important contact numbers for utilities service (Contacts) □ Keep appropriate tools for shutting off utilities in a readily accessible place
During
 Assess for damage to structure and utilities If you hear any hissing or smell gas evacuate immediately then secure utilities only if safe to do so (Evacuation) If any electrical issues are found locate main power panel Turn off all smaller breaker <u>before</u> turning off the main breaker If any major water leaks or breaks are found turn off the water
After
 Always contact a licensed professional to turn all utilities back on Never turn the gas back on without contacting the local gas company first

<u>Safety first</u>: plan ahead and follow proper utility shut off procedures
